It is our desire to provide an academic program that not only prepares a student to grow in subject content, but to see God's hand in all that is learned. God is the source of Truth and as image bearers we are to be faithful stewards of our learning/thinking. God designed man to reason; therefore, we critically apply God's word to cultural issues.
